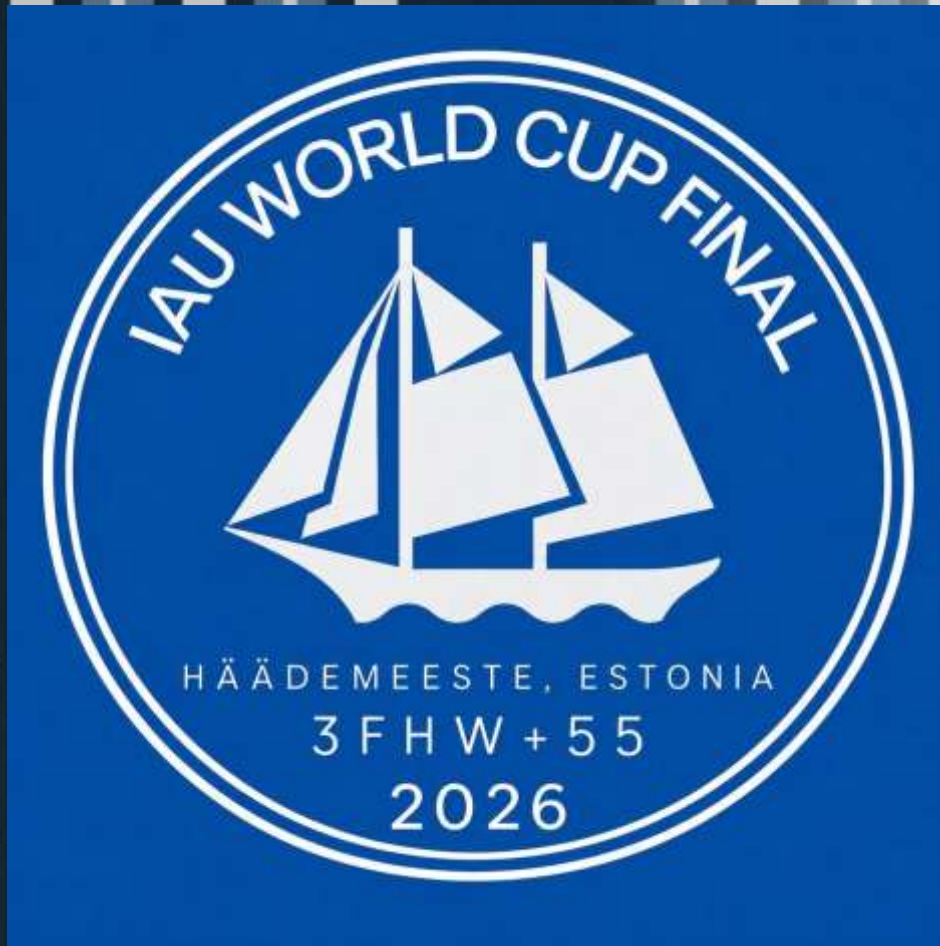

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Deadlines

Registration deadline: **October 8, 2026**

Payment deadline: **October 22, 2026**

Please meet these deadlines to ensure smooth registration. According to the IAU rules, Art. 306, participation in the World Cup Final is excluded if the corresponding entry fee has not been received in the specified account by the evening before the first day of competition at the latest.

Fees

- Entry fee per athlete: EUR 100
- Accreditation fee per official: EUR 50
- Late registration fee (October 8, 2026): EUR 50 per person
- Banquet and buffet at the shooting range: EUR 60 per person

Competition Program

Shooting Range: Indoor, 18 meters

Program: IR300 and Match Play

Categories: Men, Women, maximum 16 per category

Accreditation

To enter certain areas of the sports facility, all persons must have accreditation.

The organising committee will issue accreditations after registration and payment of the fees.

Buffet & Banquet

On competition days, a buffet will be available at the shooting range, which is included in the banquet fee. Water will be provided free of charge; other beverages must be paid for at the shooting range. The official banquet and award ceremony will take place on Saturday evening, 31 October 2026, in Häädemeeste. Like the entry fees, the buffet and banquet costs must be paid in advance.

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Accommodation

National delegations are responsible for their own accommodation.

The Organising Committee has reserved accommodation for athletes, officials and guests at Jõulumäe Health Sports Centre ([Homepage - Jõulumäe Tervisespordikeskus SA](#)), one of Estonia's leading sports and recreation facilities, located approximately 15 minutes from the competition venue.

To receive an accommodation offer, national federations and delegations are kindly requested to inform the Organising Committee of:

the number of persons requiring accommodation;

arrival and departure dates;

room preferences (single, twin, or multiple occupancy);

meal requirements (breakfast, half board, or full board).

Based on the information provided, the Organising Committee will prepare and send an individual accommodation offer together with the corresponding invoice.

Please submit accommodation requests as early as possible to ensure availability.

Transportation

Delegations are responsible for all transportation.

Customs formalities

Basically, it should not be a problem to enter Estonia with a crossbow. Crossbow is a sports-equipment and not a weapon. We recommend checking with the airline before booking flights, as well as when transiting through other countries.
